

## Using the Unbound Name

In order to protect the integrity, consistency, and growth of Unbound ministry, we offer the following guidelines for local ministries who provide Unbound ministry.

- If you are using the Unbound model as it is taught by Heart of the Father Ministries\*, and you are in a proper relationship with your local church or ministry leadership, you are welcome to use the term “Unbound ministry” to describe your ministry. You are also invited to apply to Heart of the Father Ministries to become a member of our Unbound Network. This is an association of Unbound ministry teams which are listed on our website so that people seeking ministry can locate and contact you.
- If you are combining elements of the Unbound ministry with other models of deliverance, do not use the term “Unbound ministry” to describe what you do.
- If your ministry offers Unbound ministry alongside other types of ministry, such as healing prayer and counseling, please clarify and distinguish Unbound ministry among the other options so that there will be no confusion about what people are requesting.
- Please distinguish your ministry team from Heart of the Father Ministries by clearly stating who sponsors your ministry. For example, “St. Timothy’s Unbound ministry” or “First Baptist Unbound Team.”
- Do not offer your own alternative presentations of the Unbound message without distinguishing them from the Unbound presentations created by Heart of the Father Ministries. If you do present the Unbound message in a different format, please reference your sources and identify your presentation as a non-official representation.
- If your ministry team offers training and conferences for a region, you may ask permission from Heart of the Father Ministries to call your ministry a regional name, such as “Unbound Maryland,” or “Unbound San Francisco.” Prior to using this name your team must be a member of the Unbound Network in good standing. You must also agree to additional guidelines regarding presentations.

Please respect these guidelines. We do not wish to restrain the message of Unbound, but we want those who share in our mission to understand that Unbound ministry could be limited or its reputation damaged if it is misrepresented or presented in an inconsistent manner. Consistency and a collegial approach among those doing Unbound ministry is the best hope of reproducing Unbound ministry nationally and internationally.
